Dear Senator Jackson,

I am in receipt of your correspondence of October 8, 2015 requesting that the West Indian Company Limited participate in the next committee hearing on Culture, Historic Preservation, Youth and Recreation scheduled October, 15, 2015 at 1:30 p.m. at the Earle B. Ottley Legislative Hall on St. Thomas. I understand that the purpose of the hearing is to discuss the expansion of the West Indian Company docking facilities.

I apologize but must respectfully decline your invitation due to prior previously scheduled meetings that will take place off island. The meetings have been rescheduled because of my required attendance at previous Legislative hearings and now time is of the essence to address current concerns to prevent further possible disputes.

It is my desire that the West Indian Company Limited provide you with the requested details of current and future plans for the expansion project and how it relates to the VI Port Authority, Crown Bay facility and ongoing planned Charlotte Amalie revitalization efforts. However it is not feasible given the time allotted to prepare such written testimony in the absence of my attendance at the committee hearing.
