The Office of The Governor is in receipt of your request to have a testifier present updates on the condition of Government Houses, their furnishings, art and historical collections during the committee hearing on Culture, Historic Preservation, Youth and Recreation scheduled for Friday, March 27, 2015.

Due to the extensive information requested by the committee, the office respectfully petitions additional time of 4 to 6 weeks minimum in order to accurately fulfil this request. Initial strides have been made but we still await archived reports, completion of physical inspections of 8 properties on three islands, and collaboration from various individuals with working knowledge of restoration efforts. A less hurried process is necessary in order to ensure authenticity and accuracy of the information presented to the committee and cannot be completed within a 10 day timeframe.
