

## 2017 Annual Budget

VICA accomplishes its goals and objectives by partnering with various government agencies, non-profit, national and regional organizations and individuals. A brief overview of some programs/activities executed includes, but is not limited to:

In FY 2016 VICA received an NEA grant in the amount of \$315,500.00 which was matched with \$87,000.00 local appropriation to support Territory wide programs; the NEA grant is awarded for the following components:

\$237,300.00	State Art Plan
\$ 17,500.00	Poetry Out Loud
\$ 10,200.00	Arts Education
\$ 50,300.00	Arts in Underserved Communities

The Board of Directors and staff reviewed one hundred and fifty-seven (157) grant applications requesting a total of eight hundred and sixty-eight thousand, five hundred and two and twenty-nine cents (\$868, 502.29) dollars. One hundred and thirty-four (134) grants were awarded Territory wide for a total of three hundred and ninety seven thousand, five hundred and eight (\$397,508.00) dollars. Requisite grant award letters, contracts and vouchers were processed and all funds have been expended in accordance with the grant requirements and guidelines.

**Federal Match** - VICA's 2016 federal grant from the National Endowment for the Arts (NEA) was **\$315,300.00** to be re-granted Territory wide. The funds received are required to be matched dollar for dollar with local appropriations which are also to be used for awarding grants; **\$87,000.00** was allocated for FY 16. In 2012 a request was made to the NEA to waiver the match; approval was given for a minimum match of **\$200,000.00** from the local government. This agreement has not been met and can result in jeopardizing future funding to the Territory. It is my hope that this year we can match the grant dollar for dollar.

The annual rental for VICA's office space is **36,529.00**. The Council's operations serve a significant amount of artists, craft persons and tradition bearers who do not have adequate resources and are not served by other branches of our government. As VICA

strives to explore and implement ways to provide the best service across all art disciplines at the least expense, the office also serves as a gallery space, performance area and meeting place for artisans.

**Other Services/Professional Services** - VICA is a member of Mid-Atlantic Arts Foundation (MAAF), a foundation providing financial support, residencies and art projects to state arts agencies in the Mid-Atlantic region and the Virgin Islands. And the National Assembly of State Arts Agencies (NASAA) is designed to help state arts agencies and maximize their value to the public and to state government. By participating in NASAA, state arts agencies increase their knowledge, secure resources and gain strength through a national community. NASAA also coordinates annual training for state arts agencies.

VICA's annual membership fee is **\$12,000.00** for MAAF and **\$9,195.00** for NASAA; no funds were allotted for FY2016 and the membership dues are due in April. Several years ago VICA and MAAF initiated the Virgin Islands Special Presenters Initiative to fund presenters such as Pistarckle Theater, Reichhold Center, CCT Theater, St. John Film Society, Tillett Gardens, etc., to present artists from the mid-Atlantic region. Other programs which benefit the Virgin Islands include MAAF Folk Arts Outreach Project, On Screen/In Person (tours of independent American films and their creators) and USArtists International which ensures that the impressive ranges of the performing arts is represented abroad. The affiliation with MAAF is excellent for the Territory's arts community.

**Supplies and Office Cleaning Services** - There can be no doubt that standard supplies such as paper, ink cartridges, garbage bags, and other general operating items are needed to conduct business. VICA's offices are professionally cleaned every year. This needs to be done at least twice year. This was taken out of our budget for FY16 when our budget was reduced.

VICA has developed and successfully implemented several projects that are focused on providing opportunities for students to participate in national initiatives and that ensure that the Territory's senior citizens have opportunities to experience the arts. A brief synopsis of five such programs is listed below:

**The Congressional Arts Competition:**

In partnership with the Office of the Delegate to Congress, VICA held the annual Congressional Arts Competition on St. Croix. Each spring, the Congressional Institute sponsors a nationwide high school visual art competition to encourage artistic talent in

each congressional district. St Croix Educational Complex Masa Hero Ito, was this year's winner. Delegate to Congress Stacey Plaskett hosted a reception for the students at VI Council on the Arts gallery. VICA provided funds for Mr. Ito and his chaperone to attend the National Exhibition in Washington, D.C. which is sponsored by members of Congress. The winning students' art work will be displayed for one year in the Cannon Tunnel of the Capitol.

**Poetry Out Loud** - In partnership with the National Endowment for the Arts, Mid-Atlantic Arts Foundation and the Poetry Foundation, VICA coordinates and presents the Poetry Out Loud competition. One thousand one hundred and thirteen students from eleven high schools in both districts participate over the course of six months. Irvin Mason, Jr., a senior at the All Saints Cathedral School was this year's winner. VICA arranges and pays for him and his chaperone to fly to Washington, D.C. to compete at the national level. VICA's special project coordinator and Executive Director also attend the competition and mandatory meetings.

**Artist in Residence Program** - This initiative is a part of VICA's mission to make the arts accessible to a diverse mix of students by partnering with Reichhold Center, The Forum, Caribbean Community Theater, the Department of Education and others to present artists in schools and other settings. Students receive hands on experience, training and performance techniques from visiting artists.

**Audience Development** - Through this program VICA makes tickets available for attendance to VICA funded performances. VICA partners with the Department of Human Services to ensure that transportation is provided for senior citizens, and the disabled. Tickets are also provided for at risk students to attend performances.

**Virgin Islands Presenters Initiative:** VICA successfully executed this initiative in partnership with Mid-Atlantic Arts Foundation (MAAF). MAAF provides grants to Virgin Islands presenters for performances by artists from the Mid-Atlantic region. This year CMC Arts and The forum received grants totaling \$9, 450.00.

VICA gallery space on St Thomas and Dorsh Center on St Croix is also available to the community to hosts arts based events. Some events that have been held in the past year are:

- A book signing of Juriel Hodge's "Save the Pages for Future Generations".
- A dance demonstration/reception by students from Leonard Dober, Lockhart, Ulla F. Muller, Yvonne E. Milliner-Bowsky and E. Benjamin Oliver Elementary Schools, Gift Hill, Julius Sprauve, All Saints Cathedral, Bertha C. Boschulte, Antilles and

Montessori School. These students are all a part of Dancing Classrooms Virgin Islands which Executive Director Katie Zaytoun's vision "to meaningfully participate in the development of schools and communities where every child is connected respected and provided a safe environment in which to thrive".

- Hosted a mixed-media exhibition in conjunction with Art on the Town
- Hosted a Cuban photo exhibit with Samuel Josiah James
- Coordinated and hosted the MidAtlantic Arts Foundation Board meeting reception
- Coordinated and hosted Mario Picayo's exhibit opening reception
- Participated in ART WALK with Mario Picayo

Today our islands are facing major financial challenges and all areas of funding, including the arts, are being considered for reductions in allotments. Given VICA's current funding level, cutting the arts will not have any significant impact on the budget gap; the Council expenditures comprise a very tiny fraction of the budget. The arts and culture are integral to the well-being of our community. Federal and local support for the arts offers people from all economic backgrounds access to a broad range of cultural and artistic activities Territory-wide. The Board of Directors and staff ask for your continued support.
