

**SECOND AMENDMENT OF AGREEMENT
FOR VISION CARE INSURANCE**

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 15th day of September, 2016 by and between the **Government of the Virgin Islands**, through the Health Insurance Board of Trustees (the "Board"), the Virgin Islands Port Authority (the "Authority"), the University of the Virgin Islands ("UVI"), the Virgin Islands Housing Authority ("VIHA"), the St. Thomas East End Medical Center Corporation ("East End Medical") and the Frederiksted Health Care, Inc. ("FHC") (the Board, the Authority, UVI, VIHA, East End Medical, and FHC hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Employer") and Standard Insurance Company (hereinafter "STANDARD").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Employer and STANDARD entered into an Agreement for Vision Care Insurance (the "Agreement") on September 17, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement provided for a twenty-four (24) month term ending September 30, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement was amended on October 1, 2013, to extend the current guaranteed premium rates through September 30, 2016, and to amend the Agreement to eliminate the eye examination and eye glasses lenses deductibles; and

WHEREAS, the Employer and STANDARD intend, pursuant to this Second Amendment of Agreement for Vision Care Insurance (the "Amendment"), to extend the duration of the Agreement commencing October 1, 2016 and terminating September 30, 2018, and to amend the Agreement to eliminate the co-pay for progressive lenses.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual covenants and promises made herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. The Agreement, pursuant to the terms herein, is renewed for two (2) more years commencing October 1, 2016 and terminating September 30, 2018.
2. Commencing October 1, 2016, the benefits plan under the Agreement as amended shall continue.
3. The premium rates under the Agreement are guaranteed to extend through September 30, 2018.
4. The co-pay for progressive lenses will be reduced from \$65 to \$0 (zero).
5. All terms and provisions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect.
6. This Amendment is subject to the appropriation and availability of funds and to the approval of the Governor of the U.S. Virgin Islands and the Virgin Islands Legislature.
7. For purposes of this Amendment, a photocopy or facsimile copy of the document or a photocopy or facsimile copy of a signature to the document shall have the same effect as an original. Also, this Amendment may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument.




