Thirty-first Legislature of the Virgin Islands

An Act amending title 20 Virgin Islands Code, chapter 39, section 436 to allow for discounts for obtaining or renewing taxi licenses for senior citizens

PROPOSED BY: Senator Justin Harrigan, Sr.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Virgin Islands:

SECTION 1. Title 20 Virgin Islands Code, chapter 39, section 436 is amended by designating the existing language as subsection (a) and adding subsection (b) to read as follows:

“(b) Taxi operators sixty years of age or older and domiciled in the Virgin Islands for not less than one year who are obtaining a taxi operators’ license for the first time or are renewing a validly issued taxi operators license are entitled to a discount of 50% upon the presentation of a validly issued Senior Citizen I.D. card issued by the Department of Human Services”.

BILL SUMMARY

This Bill seeks to allow taxi drivers who are senior citizens to receive a 50% discount when obtaining or renewing their driver’s license.
