

Good day Honorable Justin Harrigan, Sr. Chairman of the Committee on Government Services, Consumer and Veterans Affairs, member of the Committee, Staff, member of the listening and viewing audience. I am Levron Sarauw, Sr. Executive Director of the Virgin Islands Taxicab Commission. I am here today at your request to testify on Bill No.31-0105 an Act amending Title 3 Virgin Islands Code, Chapter 14 Section 231 requiring the Director of the Bureau of Motor Vehicles to transmit to the Director of the Virgin Islands Taxicab Commission all information pertaining to the cancellation of any insurance policy a taxicab operator is required to maintain.

Mr. Chairman we are in full agreement with this amendment. As the agency charge with the responsibility of enforcing the taxi laws we should be kept up to date on any changes made to any taxicab operator's insurance policy. This bill will give the Taxicab Commission advance information that will help us to get that particular vehicle off the road before any real damage is done.
