AMENDMENT TO BILL NO. 31-_____

Offered by Senator Justin Harrigan, Sr.

Bill No. 31-_____ is amended by adding an appropriately numbered section that reads as follows:

“SECTION ____. Title 20 Virgin Islands Code, chapter 41, section 461 is amended as follows:

(1) In subsection (a) by inserting the following at the end:

“The Director may not allow any motor vehicle with a broken or cracked windshield to pass inspection.

(2) By adding paragraphs (1), (2) and (3) to subsection (a) that read as follows:

(1) Only one registration sticker may be affixed to the windshield or license plate of the licensed vehicle. Expired registration stickers must be removed from the windshield or license plate upon the placement of the new registration sticker on the vehicle.

(2) It is unlawful to operate a motor vehicle on the public roadways with an expired registration sticker affixed to the windshield or license plate of a motor vehicle.

(3) It is unlawful for a person to drive a motor vehicle with nontransparent material other than a certificate or paper required to be displayed by law upon the front windshield. A violation of this subsection subjects the registered owner of the motor vehicle to a fine of \$100.
