An Act amending title 20 Virgin Islands Code, chapter 33, section 334 (c) pertaining to license plates

PROPOSED BY: Senator Sammuel Sanes

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Virgin Islands:

SECTION 1. Title 20 Virgin Islands Code, chapter 33, section 334 is amended by adding a sentence at the end of subsection (c) to read as follows: “ Except for dealers plates under section 336 which may be affixed to the rear window of a motor vehicle , it is unlawful to place a license plate anywhere on the dashboard of the motor vehicle or the rear window of the vehicle.

BILL SUMMARY

Section 1 of this Bill makes it unlawful to place a license plate on the dashboard or the rear window an automobile excepting temporary dealers plates.
