Bill No. 32-0186 – An Act amending Title 3 Virgin Islands Code, chapter 27, section 706, to restrict persons who held the elected positions of Lieutenant Governor and Governor from receiving two pensions

Bill No 32-0187 – An Act rezoning Parcel No. 6D Estate Thomas, New Quarter, St. Thomas from R-3 (Residential-Medium Density) to B-2 (Business-Secondary Neighborhood) and from B-2 zoning designation to granting a use variance

Bill No. 32-0189 – An Act amending Title 18, Virgin Islands Code, chapter 11, section 232 relating to primary elections to direct the Supervisor of Elections to conduct primary elections; amending chapter 17, section 410 relating to filing nomination papers to extend the time for filing; amending chapter 21, section 556 relating to the prohibition of electioneering to change distance from the polling place in which electioneering is prohibited; reprogramming and appropriation under Act No. 7904 for the operating of the election system to fund the 2018 primary elections and for other purposes

Bill No. 32-0190 – An Act amending Title 19 Virgin Islands Code, part VI by adding a new chapter 56B requiring that the Waste Management Authority designate disposal site throughout the Territory for waste tires, requiring that tire retailers charge a tire disposal fee and obtain a permit for the collection, storage, transport and disposal of waste tires, imposing a fine of \$500.00 for improper waste tire disposal, and creating the Waste Tire Management and Disposal Fund

Bill No. 32-0191 – An Act directing the Virgin Islands Waste Management Authority to designate redemption sites for waste tires, authorizing a redemption value of \$1.00 per tire subject to the availability of funds, and requiring record keeping of the transaction

eligible by the Government, including the Frederiksted Health Care, Inc., (FHC) and Cigna Health and Life Insurance Company (hereinafter “Cigna”). For purposes of this First Renewal of Group Dental Health Insurance Agreement (“First Renewal”). A Non-Profit Organization is an entity determined by the Government to satisfy the requirements under applicable Virgin Islands law for participation under the First Renewal
