## Thirty-Fifth Legislature of the Virgin Islands

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An Act granting a zoning use variance for Parcel No. Remainder 30C Estate Elizabeth, No. 8i, Great Northside Quarter, St. Thomas, from the R-2 (Residential-Low Density One and Two Family) zoning designation to allow for a scenic lookout with a restaurant/bar and gift shop

## Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Virgin Islands:

- 2 **SECTION 1.** Pursuant to title 29, Virgin Islands Code, chapter 3, section 238a, a zoning
- 3 use variance from the R-2 (Residential-Low Density One and Two Family) zoning designation
- 4 is granted for Parcel No. Remainder 30C Estate Elizabeth, No. 8i, Great Northside Quarter, St.
- 5 Thomas, consisting of 1.251 acres as described on Drawing No. D9-81 06-T008, to allow for
- 6 the development of a scenic lookout with a restaurant/bar and gift shop. All the other
- 7 requirements of the R-2 (Residential–Low Density-One and Two Family) zoning designation
- 8 continue to apply to the property.
