GENERAL FUND OF THE TREASURY OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE VIRGIN
ISLANDS TO THE VIRGIN ISLANDS DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES TO
PURCHASE AN ALL-IN-ONE MOBILE HEALTH, WELLNESS, AND PERSONAL
SAFETY DEVICES FOR VIRGIN ISLANDS SENIOR CITIZENS AND OTHER
VULNERABLE RESIDENTS, AND PAY THE ANNUAL SERVICE ASSOCIATED WITH
MAINTENANCE OF THE DEVICES.

WHILE THE PROPOSED APPROPRIATION OF \$90,000 MAY APPEAR MINIMAL IN ISOLATION, IT IS IMPORTANT TO RECOGNIZE THE BROADER FISCAL IMPACT OF CONTINUALLY DRAWING FROM THE GENERAL FUND. WE MUST EXERCISE DISCIPLINE IN MANAGING THIS FUND, ESPECIALLY CONSIDERING THAT SIGNIFICANT REDUCTIONS WERE NECESSARY TO BALANCE THE GENERAL FUND BUDGET THIS FISCAL YEAR. ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS, EVEN IN SMALL
