

BILL NO. 36-0025

Thirty-Sixth Legislature of the Virgin Islands

February 27, 2025

An Act appropriating \$90,000 from the General Fund of the Treasury of the Government of the Virgin Islands to the Virgin Islands Department of Human Services to purchase all-in-one mobile health, wellness, and personal safety devices for Virgin Islands senior citizens and other vulnerable residents, and pay the annual service associated with maintenance of the devices

PROPOSED BY: Senator Ray Fonseca

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Virgin Islands:

SECTION 1. (a) The sum of \$75,000 is appropriated from the General Fund of the Treasury of the Government of the Virgin Islands in the fiscal year ending September 30, 2025, to the Virgin Islands Department of Human Services to purchase Numera® Libris® 2mPERS all-in-one mobile health, wellness, and personal safety devices.

(b) The sum of \$15,000 is appropriated from the General Fund of the Treasury of the Virgin Islands in the fiscal year ending September 30, 2025, to the Virgin Islands to the Virgin Islands Department of Human Services to pay the annual service fee for the Numera® Libris® 2mPERS all-in-one mobile health, wellness, and personal safety devices.

(c) The funds remain available until expended.

BILL SUMMARY

This bill appropriates \$90,000 from the General Fund of the Treasury of the Government of the Virgin Islands to the Virgin Islands Department of Human Services to purchase all-in-one mobile health, wellness, and personal safety devices, and pay the annual service fee associated with maintenance of the devices.
