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#### **DEPARTMENT'S OVERVIEW**

The Virgin Islands Public Broadcasting System (WTJX) was established on November 13, 1968, by Act 2364 of the Seventh Legislature as an independent and autonomous instrumentality. As the territory's sole Public Broadcasting Service (PBS) affiliate, WTJX plays a vital role in delivering free, locally-based educational programming and public media services to a diverse audience across the Virgin Islands.

Governed by a Board of Directors and a Chief Executive Officer, WTJX expanded its reach in 2015 with the launch of WTJX-FM 93.1, the Virgin Islands' only National Public Radio (NPR) station. Regulated by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) and eligible for support from the Corporation for Public Broadcasting (CPB), WTJX also holds membership in the American Public Television System (APTS).

Approximately 85% of WTJX's funding is appropriated by the Government of the Virgin Islands, with fiscal oversight from both the Executive and Legislative Branches.

The WTJX Board of Directors is composed of eleven (11) members, appointed to guide and oversee the operations of the Virgin Islands Public Broadcasting System. The current board members are as follows:

For FY 2025, WTJX received a total appropriation of \$4,431,902 under Act No. 8916. The breakdown of fund flow is as follows:

#### • Allotments:

- \$3,323,794, representing 75% of the total appropriation.
- o **Unallotted funds**: \$1,108,109 (25%) remain unavailable for use until formally allotted.

#### • Obligations and Expenditures:

- \$3,174,677, which is 95.5% of the total allotment and 71.6% of the total appropriation.
- o All obligated funds have been fully expended.

#### • Remaining Balance:

- o \$1,257,225, or 28.4% of the total appropriation, remains available.
- o This includes the 25% in unallotted funds and an additional 3.4% in unobligated but allotted funds.

#### FISCAL YEAR 2026 BUDGET SUMMARY

The Governor has recommended a General Fund lump sum from the Miscellaneous Section of the budget for FY 2026 in the amount of \$4, 431,902. WTJX's three (3) year Financial Summary is displayed in *Exhibit II*.
