Dear Chairman Francis:

The St. Croix Chamber of Commerce strongly supports Bill No. 36-0083, which establishes a 90-day amnesty period for the waiver of penalties for payment of outstanding property taxes, income taxes, and gross receipts taxes to assist taxpayers and businesses recovering from the aftermath of Hurricanes Irma and Maria and Tropical Storm Ernesto.
