## Thirty-Sixth Legislature of the Virgin Islands

**September 10, 2025** 

An act ratifying the Governor of the Virgin Islands' approval of Major Coastal Zone Permit No. CZT-08-21(W) granted to Lime Out 2, LLC

- 1 WHEREAS, on June 26, 2025, the St. Thomas Committee of the Virgin Islands Coastal
- 2 Zone Commission approved Major Coastal Zone Permit No. CZT-08-21(W) ("the Permit") for
- 3 Lime Out 2, LLC ("the Permittee");
- WHEREAS, on July 25, 2025, the Governor of the Virgin Islands approved the Permit;
- WHEREAS, the Permit allows the Permittee to moor a floating take-out restaurant in
- 6 Lindbergh Bay, St. Thomas and to install 10 moorings for vessels visiting the restaurant;
- WHEREAS, the Permit expires 20 years after the effective date with the option to renew
- 8 the Permit within 90 days before the Permit expires, and the fees are subject to negotiations;
- 9 and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to title 12 Virgin Islands Code, chapter 21, section 911, subsection
- 11 (e), the Legislature of the Virgin Islands must ratify the Governor's approval of a major coastal
- 12 zone permit; Now, Therefore,

- 1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Virgin Islands:
- 2 SECTION 1. Pursuant to title 12 Virgin Islands Code, chapter 21, section 911,
- 3 subsection (e), the Legislature of the Virgin Islands ratifies the Governor of the Virgin Islands
- 4 approval of Major Coastal Zone Permit No. CZT-08-21(W) granted to Lime Out 2, LLC.
