

BUDGET OVERVIEW

FY 2024 Operating Budget \$105.7 Million





UNCOMPENSATED CARE

According to Title 19 Virgin Islands Code Section 221(22), "Uncompensated care" means the sum of "charity care" and "bad debt" resulting from health care services provided by the Corporation after due diligence to collect.



Schneider Regional Medical Center total "Uncompensated Care" for FY 2023 exceeds \$24 Million



LOCAL MATCH - MEDICAID

Efforts by Delegate Stacey Plaskett and other stakeholders were successful in achieving an adjustment to the FMAP for the USVI - now at 83% Federal - 17% Local.

The local match obligation from the GVI to SRMC for FY 24 is projected to be 3.1 Million.








