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1	WHEREAS, Virgin Islands physicians and healthcare facilities receiving Medicaid and
2	Medicare reimbursements are subject to the payment of all gross receipts taxes at 2.5 percent
3	imposed by the Government of the Virgin Islands; and
4	WHEREAS, TRICARE is the health care plan for uniformed service members, retirees,
5	and their families; and
6	WHEREAS, TRICARE is not subject to the payment of gross receipts taxes at 2.5%
7	as imposed by the Government of the Virgin Islands; and
8	WHEREAS, placing TRICARE on par with Medicare and Medicaid would encourage
9	Virgin Islands physicians and healthcare facilities to provide healthcare services to active-duty
10	military members, veterans, and their families, Now therefore
11	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Virgin Islands:
12	<b>SECTION 1.</b> Title 33 Virgin Islands Code, subtitle 1, part 1, chapter 3, section 43 <i>l</i> is

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amended in the following instances:

- 1 (1) By striking the first instance of "and" and inserting a comma in its place; and
- 2 (2) By adding ", and TRICARE" after "Medicare"
