The committee received an update on and discussed the current status of the Virgin Islands' disaster recovery efforts, specifically those relating to the Virgin Islands Office of Disaster Recovery but were not limited to, planned, in-process, and completed projects; the status of all federal and local funding identified for the agencies' projects, as well as any impediments with respect to the agencies' role in the territory's disaster recovery efforts with specific focus on the status of the "bundles" of disaster recovery projects.

Mrs. Adrienne L. Williams-Octalien, Director of the Office of Disaster Recovery, followed with her opening statement. Mrs. Williams-Octalien was accompanied by Mrs. Artra Watlington-Francis, Deputy Director of Finance and Compliance and Ms. Jamila Haynes, Chief Program Officer.

The Committee then conducted a seven-minute round of questioning. This concluded Block I of the day's agenda

In Block II, the Committee received an update on the status of the ongoing development of the territory's Comprehensive Land and Water Use Plan. Commissioner Jean Pierre Oriol, of the Virgin Islands Department of Planning and Natural Resources (DPNR) gave his opening statement. Commissioner Oriol was accompanied by Mrs. Leia LaPlace-Matthew (DPNR – Division of Comprehensive and Coastal Zone Planning), Ms. Jozette Walker (DPNR - Assistant Commissioner), Mr. Marlon Hibbert (DPNR – Director of the Division of Coastal Zone Management), and Ms. Hilary Lhomann (DPNR – Coastal Rezoning Coordinator, Division of Coastal Zone Management). Mr. Jeff Davis of Horsley Witten Group, DPNR's Consulting firm, participated virtually.

The Committee then conducted a six-minute round of guestioning.

Senator Milton E. Potter adjourned the meeting at 4:20pm
