An Act amending title 17 of the Virgin Islands Code pertaining to school curriculum in elementary and secondary schools

#### Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Virgin Islands:

- 2 **SECTION 1.** Title 17 Virgin Islands Code, chapter 5, section 41, subsection c is
- 3 amended as follows:

- 4 (a) Paragraph (1), as amended by Act No. 8684, is stricken and a new paragraph (1) is
- 5 inserted to read as follows:
- 6 "(1) The history of the Virgin Islands and basic Caribbean, such courses to be part 7 of the curriculum in elementary and secondary schools."
- 8 (b) Paragraph (3) is amended by striking "Family" and inserting "Drug prevention and substance education, family" and after "education" by striking "and substance abuse."

#### 10 <u>BILL SUMMARY</u>

- This bill repeals Act No. 8684 and reinstates the provisions of Act No. 4844 with
- 12 amendments. The proposed legislation still provides for Virgin Islands history and basic
- 13 Caribbean history to be taught in elementary and secondary schools.
