4. A detailed breakdown of federal grants and utilization of funds for their respective purposes or programs they support. Each school proposed plan to utilize the \$250,000 in ARPA funds.
5. A comprehensive report on the availability, accessibility, and quality of Pre-K programs.
6. Major priorities of the Board of Education for the 2023-2024 school year.
7. Concerns or issues that should be brought to the attention of the Legislature.
