Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Virgin Islands:

- 2 **SECTION 1.** This act may be cited as The Juneteenth National Independence Day Act.
- 3 SECTION 2. Title 1 Virgin Islands Code, chapter 11, section 171, subsection (a) is

- 5 (a) Insert the following language after "Last Monday in May (Memorial Day)": "June
- 6 19 (Juneteenth National Independence Day)"
- 7 (b) After the first sentence, insert the following language:
- 8 "Any national holidays listed in this subsection must be observed on the specific date or
- 9 the date observed by the federal government."
- 10 (c) In the second sentence, insert "local" before "holiday".
