Thirty-Fifth Legislature of the Virgin Islands

An Act honoring and commending Mr. Benburin "Benny" Stephens posthumously for his heroism in saving the lives of a mother and her children and to rename the Bovoni Road (Route No. 30), specifically from the entrance of the Abattoir to the entrance of the Bertha C. Boschulte Middle School, "The Benburin "Benny" Stephens Drive"

PROPOSED BY: Senators Ray Fonseca and Marvin A. Blyden 1 WHEREAS, Benburin Stephens and his wife Valeria lived in Estate Nadir, St. Thomas, 2 USVI; and 3 WHEREAS, on December 15, 1986, a large fire erupted in the kitchen at the Estate 4 Nadir home of Janice Daniel and her six children; and 5 WHEREAS, the fire quickly spread throughout the home to the living room, blocking 6 both exits, leaving Ms. Daniel and her children confined in a bedroom with no way to exit the 7 home; and 8 WHEREAS, on that evening, Mr. Stephens was at home watching television when he 9 smelled smoke and became alarmed. He investigated his neighborhood, and found Janice 10 Daniel and five of her six children, trapped inside their burning home; and 11 WHEREAS, Benburin Stephens, without any fear for himself, acted quickly and tore 12 out a set of window louvers in the bedroom, pulling the family to safety; and

1	WHEREAS, Janice Daniel was admitted to the St. Thomas Hospital with a fractured
2	leg and second degree bums on the lower parts of her body; and
3	WHEREAS, the entire Daniel's home was destroyed except for the cistern; and
4	WHEREAS, without any doubt, on that night, Benburin Stephens fearlessly and single-
5	handedly saved the lives of Janice Daniel and her children; and
6	WHEREAS, at a special ceremony held at the Fire Station, Mr. Stephens was awarded
7	the rank of Honorary Fire Chief and was presented with a plaque by Governor Alexander A.
8	Farrelly; and
9	WHEREAS, Benburin Stephens passed away on July 30, 2010; and
10	WHEREAS, it is the sense of the Legislature that Benburin Stephens has earned the
11	sincere respect and admiration of the people of the Virgin Islands; Now Therefore;
12	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Virgin Islands:
13	SECTION 1. The Legislature of the Virgin Islands, on behalf of the people of the Virgin
14	Islands, hereby honors, commends, and thanks Mr. Benburin Stephens posthumously for his
15	heroic action in saving the lives of Janice Daniel and her children.
16	SECTION 2. Bovoni Road (Route # 30), from the Abattoir entrance to the entrance of
17	Bertha C. Boschulte Middle School, is named the "The Benburin "Benny" Stephens Drive".
18	SECTION 3. The Commissioner of the Department of Public Works shall provide for the
19	erection of appropriate signage in an appropriate location on Bovoni Road bearing the
20	inscription "The Benburin "Benny" Stephens Drive".
21	SECTION 4. (a) The sum of \$8,000 is appropriated for the fiscal year ending September
22	30, 2023, from the General Fund of the Virgin Islands to the Department of Public Works for
23	the erection of signage for the purpose set forth in section 3.
24	(b) The sum appropriated in subsection (a) remains available until expended.

SECTION 5. In recognition and appreciation of his bravery, the President of the Legislature or the President's designee shall have a perma plaque copy of this act prepared and presented to the family, or the family's designee, of the late Benburin Stephens at an appropriate ceremony.

BILL SUMMARY

Section 1 honors and commends Mr. Benburin Stephens posthumously for his heroic action in saving the lives of Janice Daniel and her children. Section 2 names Bovoni Road (Route # 30), from the Abattoir entrance to the entrance of Bertha C. Boschulte Middle School, The Benburin "Benny" Stephens Drive. Section 3 directs the Commissioner of Public Works to erect the appropriate signage to commemorate the event. Section 4 appropriates the sum of \$8,000 to fund the cost of the placement of the signage. Section 5 requires the Legislature to present a perma plaque copy of the act to the family of the late Benburin Stephens at an appropriate ceremony.
