# GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS, VETERANS AFFAIRS, AND CONSUMER PROTECTION SEPTEMBER 26, 2023 COMMITTEE MEETING REPORT

The Committee on Government Operations, Veterans Affairs, and Consumer Protection held its meeting on Tuesday, September 26, 2023, at the Frits E. Lawaetz Legislative Conference Room on Croix. The Committee received and considered the following bills:

- Bill No. 35-0102 An Act honoring and commending Ralph A. deChabert, M.D. for outstanding contributions in the medical field to the people of the Virgin Islands and his many civic contributions to the community, especially to the island of St. Croix and to name the Labor and Delivery/Post Partum Unit "Maternity Services" at the Juan F. Luis Hospital and Medical Center North in his honor. This bill is sponsored by Senator Marise C. James, Esq.
- Bill No. 35-0125 An Act honoring and commending the late Police Lieutenant Melbourne Clarke posthumously for his dedication, service, and contributions to the Virgin Islands community in law enforcement by adding the name, "Police Lieutenant Melbourne Clarke Drive", at Route 669 on the island of St. Croix. This bill is sponsored by Senator Kenneth L. Gittens.

In block one of the meeting, Bill No. 35-0102 was introduced by Sen. Marise C. James, Esq. Ms. Cora Christian, MD, Ms. Ivy Ashwood, RN, Mrs. Vivian Ebbesen-Fludd, MS, RN and Mr. Angelo K. Galiber, MD testified in support of the bill. Senators proceeded with one (1) round of three (3) minutes each of questioning. Senator Gittens made a motion for Bill No. 35-0102 to be approved and forwarded to the Rules and Judiciary Committee for further consideration. The motion was seconded by Senators James, Sr., and Francis Heyliger. Voting in favor were Senators Carrion, Fonseca, Francis Heyliger, Gittens, James, Sr., Joseph, and Potter.

In the final block of the meeting, Bill No. 35-0125 was introduced by Sen. Kenneth L. Gittens. Mr. Uston Cornelius, Deputy Police Chief of the Virgin Islands Police Department and Mr. Ray Clarke testified in support of the bill. Senators proceeded with one (1) round of three (3) minutes each of questioning. Senator Gittens made a motion for Bill No. 35-0125 to be approved and forwarded to the Rules and Judiciary Committee for further consideration. The motion was seconded by Senators James, Sr., and Francis Heyliger. Voting in favor were Senators Carrion, Fonseca, Francis Heyliger, Gittens, James, Sr., Joseph, and Potter. The motion was carried.
