# GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS, VETERANS AFFAIRS, AND CONSUMER PROTECTION MARCH 26, 2024 COMMITTEE MEETING REPORT

• Bill No. 35-0030– An Act honoring and commending Vaughn Benjamin posthumously for his contributions to reggae music in the Virgin Islands and the global communities; appropriating \$45,000 to the Department of Sports, Parks, and Recreation for the design and construction of the "Vaughn Benjamin Monument" and naming waterfront park west of the Marley Homes "The Vaughn 'Akae Beka' Memorial Park".
