An Act amending Title 20 Virgin Islands Code, part II, Chapter 32, subchapter I, section 225c, relating to permit requirements for vehicles brought into the territory, to exempt authorized dealers from the permit requirements but require them to present a bill of lading

PROPOSED BY: Senator Alma Francis Heyliger

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Virgin Islands:

- 2 **SECTION 1.** Title 20, Virgin Islands Code, part II, Chapter 32, subchapter I, section
- 3 225c is amended by adding a subsection (e) that reads as follows:
- 4 "(e) A dealer as defined in section 101 in this title is exempt from the requirements
- of subsection (a) but must present a bill of lading to the Bureau of Motor Vehicles within
- 6 10 business days of bringing a motor vehicle into the Virgin Islands. Failure of the dealer
- 7 to comply with this subsection shall subject the dealer to the fine imposed in subsection
- 8 (c)."
