2	SECTION 1. Title 23, Virgin Islands Code, chapter 5 is amended by inserting the
3	following section 490:
4	"§ 490. Serial Number Requirement for Firearms
5	This Act shall be known and may be cited as the "Virgin Islands Firearm Serial Number
6	Regulation Act."
7	(a) All firearms manufactured, sold, transferred, or possessed in the Virgin
8	Islands shall have a unique serial number engraved or stamped on the firearm by the
9	manufacturer.
0	(b) It is unlawful for any person to possess a firearm that does not have a serial
1	number.
2	(c) This section does not apply to:
3	(1) Firearms that were manufactured prior to the effective date of this Act
4	if they are registered with the appropriate authority within six months of

(2) Firearms that are exempt under federal law.
