Thirty-Fifth Legislature of the Virgin Islands

An Act amending title 5 Virgin Islands Code, chapter 314, to add a section 3732a to allow for the automatic expungement of arrest records upon a finding that the arrest lacked probable cause and amending title 3 Virgin Islands Code, chapter 33, section 881(g), item 9 relating to public records to designate expunged criminal records as confidential records

PROPOSED BY: Senator Javan E. James, Sr.

- WHEREAS, the arrest of an individual without probable cause results in dismissal of the
- 2 arrest, but creates a criminal record that negatively impacts the wrongfully arrested individual;
- WHEREAS, Virgin Islands law requires the filing of a petition with the Superior Court
- 4 of the Virgin Islands to obtain an expungement of an arrest record even if there was no probable
- 5 cause;
- 6 WHEREAS, the filing of an expungement petition requires the impacted individual to
- 7 spend money and other resources and to be subjected to a civil process;
- 8 WHEREAS, the automatic expungement of arrest records for which there was no
- 9 probable cause for the arrest significantly reduces the impact of the arrest on the individual
- without subjecting the individual to a civil process or expense; Now, Therefore,

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Virgin Islands.

- SECTION 1. Title 5 Virgin Islands Code, subtitle 3, Part 1, chapter 314, is amended by
- adding section 3732a to read as follows:
- 4 "§ 3732a. Automatic expungement of criminal records of arrest for which there was no
- 5 probable cause
- When the Superior Court dismisses a criminal complaint or an information for lack of
- 7 probable cause, the Court shall simultaneously enter orders expunging the arrest record,
- 8 including fingerprints, mugshots, DNA samples, and any other police or judicial proceeding
- 9 records of a person.
- SECTION 2. Title 3 Virgin Island Code, chapter 33, section 881(g), item 9 is amended
- after "public records" by inserting "unless such records have been expunged pursuant to title
- 5, chapter 314 of the Virgin Islands Code.
