Centralize Patrol Operations: Establish a centralized command center for coordination and standardize communication protocols for deployment efficiency based on crime data analysis. Complete the Real-Time Information Center (RTIC): Allocate resources to finalize, implement and integrate current data and surveillance systems to support patrol and investigative efforts. Enhance Community Engagement: Launch community policing initiatives focused on building trust through town hall meetings and partnerships with local organizations. **Long-Term Goals** Strengthen Recruitment and Retention: Develop competitive incentive packages, mentorship programs, and ongoing professional development opportunities. Modernize Infrastructure: Upgrade all VIPD facilities to facilitate officer safety and improved working conditions. Expand Crime Prevention Programs: Increase outreach efforts, focus on youth intervention, and collaborate with stakeholders for violence reduction. Increase Sworn Personnel Footprint: Increase the number of sworn personnel for the VIPD to 100 with a suspense time of 2 years.

My strategic vision for the Virgin Islands Police Department, includes initiatives to enhance public safety, modernize law enforcement operations, and strengthen community-police partnerships.

Additionally, my experience in inter-agency collaboration, is critical to achieving comprehensive solutions to public safety challenges.
