An Act amending title 12A Virgin Islands Code, chapter 2, subchapter I, section 101 to prohibit the imposition of a surcharge for the use of a credit or debit card

PROPOSED BY: Senator Marvin A. Blyden

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Virgin Islands:

- 2 **SECTION 1.** Title 12A Virgin Islands Code, chapter 2, subchapter I, section 101 is
- 3 amended by designating the existing language as subsection (a) and inserting the following
- 4 subsections (b), (c) and (d):

- 5 "(b) No person, merchant, corporation or vendor shall impose a surcharge on a
- 6 consumer who chooses to use a credit card instead of cash, check or any similar means of
- 7 payment in any transaction that involves the sale or lease of products and services.
- 8 (c) Merchants may offer discounts to promote payment in cash, check or any other
- 9 similar method that does not involve the use of a credit card, provided that the discount is
- offered to all potential buyers.
- 11 (d) For purposes of this section the term "surcharge" means any increase in the regular
- price of a product or service imposed on the client by the merchant or lessor when using a
- 13 credit card as a method of payment."

BILL SUMMARY

- 2 This bill prohibits the imposition of a surcharge for the use of a credit or debit card in the
- 3 purchase of goods or services.
