An act amending title 18 Virgin Islands Code, chapter 23, section 622 requiring the Board of Elections to count by hand votes deposited in a ballot box

**PROPOSED BY:** Senator Franklin D. Johnson

1     *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Virgin Islands:*

2         **SECTION 1.** Title 18 Virgin Islands Code, chapter 23, section 622 is amended by  
3         designating the existing paragraph as subsection (a) and inserting the following subsections (b),  
4         (c), and (d):

5             “(b) After the paper ballots are removed from the ballot box, the votes shall be counted  
6         by hand.

7             (c) The election officers shall count the ballots in a manner that allows watchers to see  
8         the ballots when opened and read. The election officer handling the ballot after it has been taken  
9         from the ballot box may not have a marking device in hand or remove a ballot from the  
10         immediate vicinity of the polls.

1 (d) Ballots may not be counted before 8:00 p.m. on the day of the election."
