An Act amending title 14 Virgin Islands Code, chapter 85 by adding section 1710 declaring a person incapable of consent to sexual relations while the person is in police custody

1	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Virgin Islands:
2	SECTION 1. Title 14 Virgin Islands Code, chapter 85 is amended by adding section
3	1710 as follows:
4	"§ 1710. Consent; victim in police custody
5	(a) A person is incapable of consent to sexual relations when the person is
6	detained, under arrest, or is otherwise in the custody of a police officer or other law
7	enforcement official, and the offender is a police officer or other law enforcement official
8	who either:
9	(1) detained or arrested the person or is responsible for the person's
10	custody; or
11	(2) knows or should reasonably know that the person is under arrest or in
12	custody.

1	(b) The term "sexual relations" means sexual contact, sexual intercourse, or
2	sodomy as defined in section 1699 of this chapter."

4	This bill amends title 14 Virgin Islands Code, chapter 85 by adding section 1710
5	declaring a person incapable of consent to sexual relations when the person is in the custody of
6	a police officer or other law enforcement official who is either responsible for the person's
7	custody or knows or should reasonably know that the person is in custody.
