Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Virgin Islands:

2 SECTION 1. Title 1 Virgin Islands Code, chapter 7, section 103b, subsection (c) is

3 amended by striking all the language after "grant of" and inserting "\$5,000" in its place.

4 BILL SUMMARY

5 This bill amends the Centennial Treasures Award statute to provide for a single \$5,000

award payment. Under existing law, upon a person's 100th birthday, the Commissioner of the

7 Department of Human Services awards the centenarian \$4,000, and upon the death of the

centenarian, another 1,000 is awarded towards the recipient's burial. Under this bill, the

centenarian would receive the entire \$5,000 in a single payment upon the centenarian's 100th
