An act amending title 3 Virgin Islands Code, chapters 25 and 27 relating to simultaneous payment of non-legislative annuities to serving members of the Legislature of the Virgin Islands

PROPOSED BY:

1 WHEREAS, retirees who return to government service, including those elected as 2 governor or lieutenant governor, are not allowed to collect both a salary and a pension under 3 Virgin Islands law; 4 WHEREAS, current law creates a special exception for members of the Legislature of 5 the Virgin Islands, allowing them to collect both a retirement annuity for past government 6 service and their legislative salary; 7 WHEREAS, this special exception for legislators is unfair to other government retirees 8 returning to service, and undermines public trust in the government retirement system; 9 WHEREAS, this practice of is fiscally irresponsible while the Government Employees 10 Retirement System is severely underfunded and the Territory faces serious financial challenges; 11 and 12 WHEREAS, repealing this special exception will bring consistency to the law, support 13 fairness and help to protect the long-term health of the public pension system; Now, Therefore,

1	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Virgin Islands:
2	SECTION 1. Title 3 Virgin Islands Code is amended as follows:
3	(a) In chapter 25, section 714, by striking subsection (g) and redesignating the
4	remaining subsections accordingly; and
5	(b) In chapter 27, section 763 by striking subsection (g) and redesignating the
6	remaining subsections accordingly.
7	SECTION 2. This act takes effect 90 days after enactment.
