An Act amending title 2 Virgin Islands Code, chapter 1 by adding a section 10 providing a penalty for the commission of perjury in proceedings before the Legislature of the Virgin Islands

## Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Virgin Islands:

- 2 **SECTION 1.** Title 2 Virgin Islands Code, chapter 1 is amended by adding section 10
- 3 that reads as follows:

- 4 "§ 10. A person is personally liable for a fine of not less than \$250 or imprisoned for
- 5 not more than 30 days, who in, or in connection with, any proceeding, hearing, or inquiry
- 6 before the Legislature of the Virgin Islands —
- 7 (1) swears or affirms—
- 8 (A) that he will truly testify, declare, depose, or certify; or
- 9 (B) that any testimony, declaration, deposition, certificate, affidavit, or other
- writing subscribed by him is true; and
- 11 (2) willfully and knowingly testifies, declares, deposes, or certifies falsely or states in
- 12 his testimony, deposition, affidavit or certificate any matter to be true which he knows to be
- false."

## 1 <u>BILL SUMMARY</u>

- 2 This bill makes it unlawful to provide false testimony under oath in proceedings before
- 3 the Legislature of the Virgin Islands and subjects the person to be personally liable for a fine
- 4 of not less than \$250 or to imprisonment of not more than 30 days.
